- 5. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to

increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- Ø Ø Bidders are advised to quote prices as per technical specification.
- Ø The equipment should be supported with spares for a minimum period of 10 years after successful installation and commissioning." All the spares and consumables required for the equipment should be made available through GeM throughout the agreed supporting period". (A line of confirmation should be submitted along with the bid document.)
- Ø The bidder should submit a declaration confirming that the Product Cost/ Total Cost does not include warranty charges other than OEM Warranty. If any charges claimed by the bidder towards three years warranty which is included in the product cost/total cost should be indicated in the declaration form. Aforesaid declaration should be submitted along with technical bid. On request split up of warranty cost (year wise) shall be provided by the bidder after price bid opening.
- Ø As per Institute policy CAMC should be a maximum of 5 % of equipment cost and escalation, if any (maximum 5 %) should be considered once in every three years. CAMC charges should be calculated excluding the extended warranty cost, if any, and GST of the equipment.
- Ø The supplier shall enter into CAMC with SCTIMST, 3 (three) months prior to the completion of Warranty Period. The CAMC will commence from the date of expiry of the Warranty Period.
- Ø Liquidated Damages:
- Ø If the supplier fails to deliver or install/commission any or all of the goods or fails to perform the services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the Purchase Order, the Purchaser shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to the Purchaser under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to 0.5% per week of delay or part thereof on delayed supply of goods, installation, commissioning and/or services until actual delivery or performance subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract price. Once the maximum is reached Purchaser may consider termination of the contract.

If any delay by the supplier in maintaining its contractual obligations towards delivery of goods and performance of services shall render the supplier liable to any or all of the following sanctions:

Performance parameters:

- A. Flow rate in LPM: Change to Inspiratory flow up to 160 LPM
- **B.** No medical gas should be consumed in operating ventilator. There should be decoupling of fresh gas flow.
- **C.** Virtual gas flow meter should be displayed onscreen.
- **D.** System should calculate anaesthetic agent consumption and uptake by patient with display of utilization of fresh gas

3. Service & Support

The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of EMD, the FDR will be released in the favour of the bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Bidder has to upload scanned copy/ proof of the FDR along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date/ Bid Opening date

6. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

Bidders shall quote only those products in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and has at least 7 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not be declared end-of-life by the OEM before this period.

8. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

9. Generic

11. Forms of EMD and PBG

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of Director payable at Trivandrum. The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. - 1.CMC shall include preventive maintenance including calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares, after satisfactory completion of Warranty. During the CMC period commencing from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturer's technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months or as per user requirement. Cost of consumables shall not be included in CMC.Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during CMC period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend CMC period by double the downtime period.
- 2.CMC charges to be indicated as percentage of cost of equipment quoted for each year after the warranty period.
- 3.GST shall be included in the CMC Charges quoted.
- 4.Cost of CMC will be added for Ranking/Evaluation purpose with depreciation formula. A 10% discounting rate per year shall be applied on CMC Charges for price evaluation on Net Present Value.
- 5. The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user.

8.1.Buyer shall indicate number of years of warranty by selecting different options available in the field depending on warranty parameter applicable in category parameters for the equipment. 8.2. The calculation of CMC Charges shall take into account the number of years of warranty and duration of CMC as specified while creating bid.

8.3.In the price evaluation, the system shall provide function to calculate the cost of each equipment by formula indicated below includingCMC and then show the inter-se-ranking of the bidders. The following are the variables

- (i) Number of years for which CMC required.
- (ii) Number of years of product warranty

If 2 year warranty specified, n shall be2 and if 5 year warranty specified, n shall be 5. A1,A2, A3, A4& A5shall depend on how many years CMC selected. For3 yearCMC, only A1,A2 and A3 factors are to be taken into account and A4 and A5 will not be applicable.

- 8.4.CMC charges offered for each subsequent year should be same or higher than preceding year.
- 8.5. The CMC charges shall be offered within range of 3 to 10% of cost of equipment.
- 9. Since CMC charges are to be paid only later for each year during CMC period, applicable performance guarantee amount after placement of contract shall be based on the cost of equipment excluding the cost of CMC Charges.
- 10.Performance bank guarantee applicable for CMC is to be submitted at start of the CMC and shall be applicable between 2.5% to 5% as specified in bid on total CMC Charges. - 13.CMC Charges are inclusive of all the charges for Transportation, Lodging, Boarding, all insurances including third party insurance and all other incidental charges. The same shall include GST. The prices also include cost of spares and damaged parts. Purchaser does not have any liability, whatsoever, over and above the cost of CMC. It also includes for arranging hand tools & tackles, special tools etc. required to carry out the work.
