4. 5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

6. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Generic

Cost per reportable test will be paid by the Institute in sub sequent months subject to conditions as per tender document.		
2	The contract will be awarded initially for a period of five years extendable for further five years o r more on the same terms & conditions, on mutual consent of both the parties and satisfactory p erformance of the successful bidder / its OEM. The Institute will, however, reserve the right to co nduct performance review every year during the contract period and deficiencies / non complian ce reported, if any, noticed shall be required to be rectified by the successful bidder within a rea sonable time fixed by the Institute. Furthermore the successful bidder has to submit a declaratio n in accordance with clause No.18 (annually) and this will also taken into account for the assess ment of satisfactory performance. This Institute reserves the right to suo-motu terminate the co ntract without any notice at any point of time. The rate quoted will be frozen for entire contract period including extended period if any, without escalation. However, increase / decrease in GS T will be considered.		
	The equipment on offer should have the capability to perform following tests. 4	Rate of Cost Per Reportable Test to be quoted. which will include all incidental expenses, cost of reagent, calibrators, controls, cuvettes, probes, washing solution, resins (if applicable), GST etc. The calibrators, controls, etc will be used as per NABL stipulation. All breakdown maintenance, tr ansportation, loading and unloading, spare parts & AMC/CAMC, preventive maintenance kit, rem edial maintenance service and calibration shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder at their o wn risk cost and expenses. Additional requirement (if any) as per specification document should be provided free of cost.		
5	The equipment on offer should be brand new and having the facility to generate successful / uns uccessful test results list and must meet all technical specification / features according to the te nder document. Details of tests performed must be generated from the equipment as and when required by the department. The successful bidder should install the equipment within 7 days fr om the date of issuance of GeM contract and must be operational from the subsequent days.		
6	The laboratory of SCTIMST is integrated with Laboratory Information System (LIS). The supplier will have to integrate the equipment with the existing SCTIMST's LIS at their own cost. The succ essful bidder should integrate their instruments in such a way that this facility can be provided uninterruptedly to the beneficiaries.		
7	The Institute will provide an air-conditioned environment, if necessary with uninterrupted power supply for the working of the system. However, the successful bidder has to provide compatible online UPS with 30 min. battery backup along with the equipment.		
8	The company should have at least 05 nos. of installations/rate contract/Cost per reportable test contract of similar equipment in any Central / State Govt. Organization / PSU / Public Listed Com pany in India. The documentary evidence should be attached along with technical bid.		
9	The rate offered by the bidder should be same or lower than in any Central / State Govt. Organiz ation / PSU / Public Listed Company in Kerala State that does the same number of tests per year. A Notarized affidavit to this effect has to be submitted by the bidder along with technical bid reg arding fulfilment of this condition.		
10	The equipment manufacturer and reagent manufacturer must be the same and a declaration in t his regard shall be uploaded along with technical bid.		
11	The successful bidder should replace or upgrade equipment with newer version on mutually agr eed terms, as per availability of newer model in market, subject to approval from SCTIMST.		

12	The successful bidder should keep an adequate buffer stock of the reagents and consumables et c required to conduct the test at SCTIMST and ensure that the testing procedures are not interru pted even in a shift due to the lack of reagents and other consumables. The Life period of any of the item supplied by the successful bidder will have the minimum of two third of the expiry perio d remaining on the date of receipts of items in SCTIMST. The supplied items having less than tw o-third expiry period to SCTIMST shall not be accepted. Loss or premature deterioration due to b iological and/or other factors during life span of stores against the manufacture's standard warra nty/expiry of such items shall be replaced by the contractor on free of cost basis.
13	The equipment, reagents and consumables, etc required to perform the test must have a valid I ndian product certification. If, there is no valid Indian product certification available, then the ite ms on offer should have USFDA/CE product certification. Documentary evidence should be attac hed along with technical bid.
14	On-site training to Staffs/Technicians/Faculties to be provided by bidder representative of OEM with regards to operation and maintenance of the equipment to be done through the entire cont ract period including extended period if any, as and when requested by the Institute at no extra cost to the institute.
15	SCTIMST reserves the right to ask for a free demonstration (Online / Offline) of the quoted equip ment/items after giving reasonable time to the bidder at a pre-determined place acceptable to t he purchaser or at a site (in case of non-portable and heavy equipment) for evaluating the techni cal compatibility as per the bidding document specifications, professionalism and quality of work of the bidder for technically qualifying for opening the price bid. SCTIMST reserves the right to ac cept/reject the bid based on the product/site evaluation as stated above.
16	The bidder/OEM should have a registered functional office at Kerala State and documentary evid ence should be uploaded along with technical bid. Service Engineer shall be available on any br eak down or emergency calls. If he/she fails to repair it within 24 hrs, a standby instrument shoul d be provided by the successful bidder until the rectification of the fault. The contractor will anal yze the quality control once in a month to check the performance of the instrument.
17	In case, the successful bidder fails to get the tests done as per clause 2 and 3 above, SCTIMST re serves the right to send the samples and get the tests done from any accredited labs and recove r the cost from the successful bidder. In addition, a penalty of 2% of the cost incurred will also b e levied on each occasion. In the event, such occasions exceed more than three in a year; the In stitution reserves the right to terminate the contract.
18	If at any time during the period of contract, the price of cost per reportable test is reduced or bro ught down by any law or Act of the Central or State Government or by the bidder himself, below the contracted rate, their contracted rate will stand reduced automatically to the reduced level. Failure to provide reduced rate will be deemed as withdrawal from the tender and contract and s hall be dealt with accordingly. If supplies are made at higher rates after the reduction of rate, pa yments will be eligible at the reduced rates only.
19	Payment Clause
19.1	The bill in triplicate shall be provided to Department of Biochemistry, SCTIMST within first week of subsequent month. Monthly bill should be generated after calculating the number of reportabl e tests for each line of items. The invoice should be accompanied by the list of successful / unsu ccessful tests. No payment will be made for the unsuccessful tests due to any reason whatsoeve r. Further no payment will be made for goods rejected due to any reason whatsoever.
19.2	The bills should have full particulars of the numbers of each kind of test done during the invoice period.
19.3	The number of tests in the bill submitted should match with the records generated in the supplie d equipment.
19.4	No payment shall be made in advance at any circumstance whatsoever.

19.5	Bills for the month will be accepted only after ensuring supply of buffer stock of reagents, consu mables, etc for performing tests for the subsequent months. This is for the smooth running of the patient care services.
19.6	Payment will be made within 30 days of submission of invoice with relevant documents as menti oned in the tender document after making deductions for defaults, if any.
20	If at any time during the continuance of the contract, the performance in whole or in part by eith er party of any obligation under this Contract shall be prevented or delayed by the reasons of an y war, hostility, acts of the public enemy, epidemics, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, ex plosion, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God provided notice of happening of s uch event duly evidenced with documents is given by one party to the other within 10 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall be by reasons of such event, be entitled to te rminate the contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in resp ect of such non-performance or the delay in performance, and deliveries under the contract shal l be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist, and the decision of the Purchaser as to whether the deliveries have been so resumed or not, shall be final and conclusive, Provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation u nder this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 1 0 days, either party may at its option terminate the contract provided also that the purchaser sh all be at liberty to take over from the Seller at a price to be fixed by Purchaser, which shall be fi nal, all unused, undamaged and accepted material, bought out components and stores in cours e of manufacture in the possession of the Seller at the time of such termination or such portion t hereof as the Purchaser may deem fit excepting such materials, bought out components and stores in cours e of manufacture in the concurrence of the Purchaser elect to retain.
21	In case of breach of any terms and conditions of this contract, the competent authority, will have the right to cancel the contract without assigning any reason thereof and nothing will be payabl e by SCTIMST and in that event the security deposit shall also stands forfeited.
22	If fails to fulfill any or all of the Services or delay in delivery within the original/re-fixed Delivery/T ime period(s) specified in the Contract, the Institute will be entitled to deduct/recover the Penalt y / Liquidated Damages for the delay from the security deposit/monthly bills, unless covered und er Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value without any controversy/disput e of any sort whatsoever. Cumulative Penalty cannot exceed more than 10% of the total contract value after which the Institute shall have the right to get the service/rectification done from alter nate sources at the risk and cost of the service provider besides forfeiture of PBG.
