- 1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017, Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 4. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

## Special terms and conditions-Version:3 effective from 21-10-2022 for category Multipara Monitor - Low End

- All Provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules made there under as amended till date will always be applicable. This will include all notifications issued by *Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation(CDSCO)*, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) and Department of Pharmaceuticals (DOP), Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers time to time in this regard.
  - 2. The sellers are registered on GeM based on self-declaration of valid Drug License, product certification, test reports etc. However, buyers must check and validate the details at their end for all applicable licenses and certifications e.g., validity and authenticity/genuineness of drug license, product certification, manufacturer certification/licenses, test reports etc.
  - 3. The price offered by the seller shall not, in any case exceed the DPCO controlled price, if any, fixed by the Central/State Government, the Maximum Retail Price (MRP) and the selling price. The seller must reduce the prices if there is any reduction in DPCO ceiling price, if any.
  - 4. **Comprehensive warranty:** Comprehensive warranty shall include preventive maintenance including calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares. During the warranty period commencing from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturer's technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months. warranty shall not be including the consumables. Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during warranty period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend warranty period by double the downtime period.
  - 5. Service centres: Details of Service outlets in India to render services for equipment to be furnished to buyer/consignees with complete address, telephone numbers, e mails etc at time of making the supplies. It shall be the responsibility of seller to ensure that authorized service centres are available to cater to the areas where supplies are made within reasonable distance from where the service calls can be handled. Details of toll-free numbers for service call and online registration of service requests also to be provided buyer/consignee at the time of supplies.
  - 6. **Source of supply:** It shall be responsibility of seller to provide Documents regarding source of equipments such as copy of Performa invoice or any other documents to establish that the products supplied are manufactured by OEM indicated and sourced from them.
  - 7. **Packing and Marking:** Medical equipments being very delicate and sensitive packing for the goods should be strong and durable enough to withstand transit including transhipment (if any), rough handling, open storage etc. without any damage, deterioration etc. .The size, weights and volumes of the packing cases, remoteness of the final destination of the goods, availability or otherwise of transport and handling facilities at all points during transit up to final destination,. Quality of packing, the manner of marking within & outside the packages and provision of accompanying documentation shall take into consideration the type of medical equipments being supplied. The accessories shall be suitably labelled and packed. Each of the package shall be marked on three sides with indelible paint of proper quality: indicating contract number and date, brief description of goods including quantity, Packing list reference number, country of origin of goods and any other relevant details.
  - 8. **Spare Parts:** Seller shall provide materials, information etc. pertaining to spare parts manufactured and supplied by the OEM. It shall be ensured that the required spares are available for purchase at least for 10 years from date of supplies. In case due to any reasons the production of the spare parts is discontinued sufficient advance notice should be given to the buyer/consignee before such discontinuation to provide adequate time to purchase the required spare parts etc. Further, OEM and their service centres/dealers shall carry sufficient inventories to assure ex-stock supply of consumables and spares for the equipments so that the same are available.

OEM or reseller shall always accord most favoured client status to the buyer/consignee and shall give the most competitive price for spares and consumables of its machines/equipments supplied.

- 9. **Installation, Training, Manuals:** Seller shall be responsible to carry out Installation & commissioning, Supervision and Demonstration of the goods. They shall provide required jigs and tools for assembly, minor civil works for the completion of the installation and Training of Consignee's representatives for operating and maintaining the equipment and supplying required number of operation & maintenance manual for the goods. In case the category parameters are specifying any requirements regarding the installations, training and manuals the same shall also be applicable.
- 10. **Electrical safety checking:** Sellers are required to make sure that they furnish the list of equipments for carrying out routine and preventive maintenance to buyer/consignee .They should make sure to periodically check the electrical safety aspects as per BIS Safety Standards or equivalent .In case they do not have required equipment for such testing should ensure that the equipments checked for electrical safety compliance through labs with facilities for such checking during every preventive maintenance call.
- 11. Software: All software updates should be provided free of cost during warranty period.
- 12. Any other Terms and Conditions which is not included or at variance with the conditions specified in STC/GTC, may be added by the buyer through Additional Terms and Conditions in the bid to ensure items are procured from authentic/validated source with appropriate and applicable quality. The above terms and conditions are in reverse order of precedence i.e. ATC shall supersede specific STC which shall supersede General Terms and Conditions ("GTC"), whenever there are any conflicting provisions.

#### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

#### 2. Service & Support

Availability of Service Centres: Bidder/OEM must have a Functional Service Centre in the State of each Consignee's Location in case of carry-in warranty. (Not applicable in case of goods having on-site warranty). If service center is not already there at the time of bidding, successful bidder / OEM shall have to establish one within 30 days of award of contract. Payment shall be released only after submission of documentary evidence of having Functional Service Centre.

#### 3. Generic

**Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

#### 4. Generic

Bidders shall quote only those products (Part of Service delivery) in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and has at least 7 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not be declared end-of-life by the OEM before this period.

#### 5. Warranty

Bidder / OEM has to give an undertaking that after expiry of warranty period, it will provide Comprehensive Maintenance Service for next 5 years for the offered products at the rate not more than 5 % of contract price per annum. Buyer reserves the right to enter into a CMC agreement with the Successful Bidder / OEM after expiry of the Warranty period at above mentioned rate and the payment for the CMC charges would be made Biannually after rendering of the CMC Services of the relevant CMC period. Performance Security of the successful bidder shall be forfeited if it fails to accept the CMC contract when called upon by the buyer. CMC would include cost of

#### 6. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

#### 7. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

- A. A. Bidders are advised to quote prices as per technical specification and additional specification. However detailed breakup of quoted prices should be provided in Price Format A (in pdf) and uploaded in the prescribed place (Financial Docum ent Required) on online GeM portal. The prices quoted in the prescribed field on GeM portal will be considered for ranking purpose. Total price quoted in Price Format A (in pdf) must match with the price quoted in GeM portal.
  - B. The Bidders are advised to quote price of Spare parts, Consumables in the attac hed format (pdf) B and C accordingly and uploaded the same in the prescribed p lace (Financial Document Required) on online GeM portal. The equipment shoul d be supported with spares for a minimum period of 10 years after successful in stallation and commissioning." All the spares and consumables required for the equipment should be made available through GeM throughout the agreed supporting period".
  - C. Care should be taken that no price elements to be revealed in the technical bid, w hich may lead to the rejection of the bid.
    - D. The three years warranty sought for is **OEM free warranty** without any additio nal cost towards extended warranty to fulfil the tender condition. The charges, i f any, claimed by the bidder towards warranty in this regard and included in the product cost in Price Format -A should be mentioned in the price format D also. This warranty charges shall not be considered for calculating actual CAMC value to be payable after warranty period. Where the total cost does not include such warranty charges, the bidder shall submit a declaration- "Certify that the Equip ment/accessories quoted in the bid is having OEM free warranty of three years and the total cost quoted in the bid does not include any warranty charges to ful fil the tender condition of three year warranty". This declaration shall be furnish ed along with the Technical bid. False declaration may lead to rejection of bid. #### H. Liquidated Damages:

If the supplier fails to deliver or install/commission any or all of the goods or fails to perform the services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the Purchase Order, the Purchaser shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to the Purchaser under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to 0.5% per week of delay or part thereof on delayed supply of goods, installation, commissioning and/or services until actual delivery or performance subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract price. High end multipara monitors are used in the critical care unit(CCU), Operation theatres and in post anesthesia care units(PACUs) and ICU
